POLICY MANUAL UPDATES AND ADDITIONS

5.9 Attendance:

All City employees are expected to be at work on time and during their regularly scheduled hours. Employees who are unable to report for work on time are required to notify their immediate supervisor prior to their being absent, unless an emergency exists. If an emergency situation exists, the employee is expected to notify the proper authority as soon as reasonably possible. Except in cases of an emergency, if an employee is absent more than three (3) consecutive days without proper notification, the employee will be considered to have voluntarily resigned their position and/or may be discharged from City service. ADD: Regular attendance is an essential job requirement and the City does not have to accommodate "erratic or unreliable attendance."

6.4 Benefits:

- 1. Insurance: Full-time employees may voluntarily waive the City's employee health and/or-dental insurance benefits if they are covered under another health insurance plan by signing the waiver form at the Finance Office. **REMOVE:** and/or dental
- 3. Recreation Membership: All full-time City employees and active Volunteer Firefighters, as well as the Volunteer Firefighters immediate family, are allowed the benefit of using the Recreation Center and its facility during normal hours of operation at no charge. Immediate family for firefighters includes spouse and dependent children only. The value of the membership is taxable under IRS regulations. ADD: (This was inadvertently left out of the new manual.) Retired City of Deadwood employees are allowed to use the Rec Center free of charge.

6.8 Meal Compensation:

At the discretion of the Department Head, the City may provide one meal per day at a maximum cost of \$12.00 per employee, when a work situation precludes him/her from being able to leave his/her work station to get a regular meal on his/her own. This will be limited to emergency situations and election days, only after the completion of the employee's normal workday. The employee must pay the difference between \$12.00 and the actual cost of the meal, if any, and there will be no refund if the total meal cost is less than \$12.00.

CHANGE TO: At the discretion of the Department Head, the City may provide one meal per day, per employee, when a work situation precludes him/her from being able to leave his/her work station to get a regular meal on his/her own. Meal allowance will be paid at the current state rates. This will be limited to emergency situations and election days, only after the completion of the employee's normal workday. The employee must pay the difference if over the allotted amount for the meal, if any, and there will be no refund if the total meal cost is less than the allotted amount.

6.9 Volunteer Firefighters:

If a Deadwood volunteer firefighter, while working his/her regularly scheduled shift for the City of Deadwood, is requested to assist at the scene of a fire within the City limits, said employee will receive regular pay for the amount of hours in which he/she is fighting the fire, during his/her regularly scheduled working hours (i.e., employee's shift is from 7:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. and is called to a fire at 1:00 p.m. and does not leave the fire scene until 9:00 p.m., this employee would be paid for two (2) hours by the City of Deadwood). If called on to fight a fire within the State of South Dakota in areas other than the City limits, the employee shall be entitled to receive regular pay while absent without loss of annual leave, less pay received from the State & Federal Forest Service. Should the State & Federal Forest Service pay exceed the amount due to the City, the employee shall be entitled to the balance of the pay. **ADD THIS SECTION TO THE MANUAL.** (This was inadvertently left out of the new manual.)

6.10 Lifeguard Certification Reimbursement:

Lifeguards will be reimbursed \$100.00 for lifeguard reimbursement; \$50.00 after first six months of employment and \$50.00 after one year of employment. Receipt of payment must be provided for reimbursement. (ADD FROM OLD MANUAL)

6.11 CDL Testing Reimbursement

CDL drivers will be reimbursed for the cost of taking the CDL driving test only, provided they have passed and paid for their written test. Receipt of payment must be provided for reimbursement. (ADD FROM OLD MANUAL)

7.3.2 Sick Bank: All regular, full-time employees must be employed for one full year before becoming eligible to utilize the sick bank. After completing one full year of service, the employee may contribute sixteen (16) hours of sick leave to the bank. After the first year of service, and after the first sixteen (16) hours have been contributed to the bank, the employee may contribute eight (8) hours of sick leave to the bank on an annual basis. Once the employee has donated for fifteen (15) years contributions are no longer requested.

CHANGE TO: All regular, full-time employees must be employed for one full year before becoming eligible to utilize the sick bank. After completing one full year of service, the employee may contribute sixteen (16) or twenty (20) hours of sick leave to the bank, depending on daily work schedule. After the first year of service, and after the first sixteen (16) or twenty (20) hours have been contributed to the bank, the employee may contribute eight (8) or ten (10) hours of sick leave to the bank on an annual basis. Once the employee has donated for fifteen (15) years contributions are no longer requested.

7.13 Holidays:

When a holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday is observed as the paid holiday for eligible City employees. If a holiday falls on a Sunday, it is observed on the following

Monday. ADD: For payroll purposes, City departments working a seven-day per week schedule shall observe all holidays on the day the holiday falls.

AMENDMENT NUMBER 1 TO AGREEMENT NUMBER 614591

BACKGROUND:

- 1. On March 20, 2017, the State of South Dakota, acting by and through its Department of Transportation, referred to in this Amendment as the "STATE," and the City of Deadwood, referred to in this Amendment as the "CITY," entered into a joint powers financial and maintenance agreement for Project Number PH 8041(19) PCN 04L7, which agreement, referred to in this Amendment as the "AGREEMENT," was signed by representatives of each party and assigned Agreement Number 614591 by the STATE.
- The parties wish to amend the AGREEMENT to reflect a change in project number to match what has been changed in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program ("STIP"). The Project Number referenced in the AGREEMENT is <u>PH 8041(19) PCN 04L7</u>. The Project Number should be referenced as <u>PH 00SW(52) PCN 05M6</u>.

THE PARTIES MUTUALLY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Paragraph 2 of the AGREEMENT is revised to read as follows:
 - 2. STATE PROJECT

The STATE and the CITY concur in the proposal for the Sign and Delineation project identified as Roadway Safety Improvement Project Number PH 00SW(52) PCN 05M6, located on various CITY roads in the city of Deadwood, referred to in this Agreement as the "PROJECT."

- 2. Except as modified by this Amendment the terms and conditions of the AGREEMENT will remain in full force and effect.
- 3. The CITY has designated its Mayor as the CITY'S authorized representative and has empowered the Mayor with the authority to sign this Amendment on behalf of the CITY. 





Ordinance #XXXX

AN ORDINANCE CREATING CHAPTER 3.32 ESTABLISHING AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVE PROGRAM FOR HOUSING.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Deadwood, South Dakota the definition in Chapter 17.08; Section 17.08.010, 'Dwelling' and 'Vacant Building' shall be defined as follows:

'Dwelling' means a building or portion thereof, designed or used for residential occupancy. The term dwelling shall not be construed to mean motels, hotels, boarding houses, tourist homes or mobile homes whether in a mobile home park or not.

"Vacant Building" means a building that has been abandoned, unoccupied, or empty for a certain amount of time. In the context of buildings within the City Limits of Deadwood, vacancy shall be determined by a vacant period of time set at two years.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Deadwood, South Dakota that Chapter 3.32 be added and read as follows:

3.32 Municipal Property Tax Rebate

To encourage construction of new housing and rehabilitation of vacant housing in the City of Deadwood, a rebate of the City of Deadwood municipal property tax is hereby established as follows:

- (A) The rebate will apply to any single-family, two-family, and multi-family dwellings, but not including hotels, motels, or lodging houses, and that are constructed to the standard of existing city ordinances and granted a final inspection certificate for occupancy after January 1, 2018. For the purposes of Ordinance 3.32, mobile homes whether or not in a mobile home park will not be eligible for the rebate of municipal property tax.
- (B) The rebate shall be for five years, commencing the year following the issuance of the occupancy certificate.
- (C) Property located within a TIF Boundary are not eligible for a Municipal Property Tax Rebate

The rebate shall only apply to the City of Deadwood municipal property taxes. The rebate of City Municipal property taxes shall be paid to the owner of the real property by December 1st of each year after it has been received by the City of Deadwood, without an interest and shall not act as a credit toward any State or Federal taxes. The City of Deadwood shall have the right to withhold any or the entire rebate to offset any unpaid assessments on the real property, or any fines, judgments, or other debts owed to the City of Deadwood by said owner.

This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the date of publication pursuant to SDCL-9-19-13.

"Owner" means a person, as defined by this code, who, alone, jointly or severally with others, or in a representative capacity (including without limitation, an authorized agent, executor, or trustee) has legal or equitable title to any property in question.

"Occupant" means any person living in, sleeping, possessing, or otherwise using any land, building, or part thereof.

A Proposed Definition

"Vacant Building" means a building that has been abandoned, unoccupied, or empty for a certain amount of time. In the context of buildings within the City Limits of Deadwood, vacancy shall be determined by a vacant period of time set at two years.

State Statute

22-33-9.5. Occupied structure defined. For the purposes of chapter 22-33, the term, occupied structure, means any structure, vehicle, or place adapted for overnight accommodation of persons, or for carrying on business therein, whether or not a person is actually present. Property is that of another, for the purposes of this section, if anyone other than the actor has a possessory or proprietary interest in the property. If a building or structure is divided into separately occupied units, any unit not occupied by the actor is an occupied structure of another.

10-13-39. Classification of owner-occupied single-family dwelling. Each owner-occupied single-family dwelling in this state is specifically classified for the purpose of taxation. For the purposes of this section, an owner-occupied single-family dwelling is a house, condominium apartment, residential housing consisting of four or less family units, town house, town home, housing cooperatives where membership in the cooperative is strictly limited to stockholder occupants of the building, dwelling as classified in § 10-13-39.1, and manufactured or mobile home as defined in § 32-3-1, which is assessed and taxed as a separate unit, including an attached or unattached garage and the parcel of land upon which the structure is situated as recorded in the records of the director of equalization. A person may only have one dwelling, which is the person's principal place of residence as defined in § 12-1-4, classified as an owner-occupied single-family dwelling. If the owner occupies fifty percent or more of the living space within the dwelling, the entire dwelling is classified as an owner-occupied single-family dwelling. If the owner occupies a duplex, triplex, or fourplex, or less than fifty percent of the living space within the dwelling, the portion of the dwelling so occupied shall be classified as an owner-occupied single-family dwelling.

10-13-39.2. Review of owner-occupied single-family classifications determined before July 1, 2005. No amendment to § 10-13-40 made pursuant to SL 2005, ch 62, § 1, compels the director of equalization to review any owner-occupied single-family classifications determined before July 1, 2005. However, the director of equalization may review such classifications if information is provided or discovered concerning the eligibility of any dwelling that is classified as an owner-occupied single-family dwelling.

10-13-39.3. Ownership requirements for classifying dwellings as owner-occupied. For the purposes of §§ 10-13-39 and 10-13-40, an owner shall be the owner of the owner-occupied dwelling as recorded by the director of equalization in the county where the dwelling is located. A joint tenant, an owner of a life estate, a partner, a person owning an interest in a limited liability company, a person owning an interest in a corporation, a vendee of a contract for deed, or a beneficiary of a trust is considered to be an owner.

An owner may claim a credit only on the single-family dwelling used as a principal residence. An owner may have more than one parcel of land classified as owner-occupied if the additional parcel is contiguous to the parcel containing the owner-occupied house. Each parcel that is contiguous, under the same ownership and used as one property shall be considered as owner-occupied. A property is also considered contiguous if separated by a street or alley from the parcel containing the owner-occupied house.

If the dwelling is occupied by a parent of the owner, the parent is considered the owner and occupant of the single-family dwelling.

The owner or a legal representative of the owner may sign for signature purposes on the certification of an owner-occupied dwelling.

10-13-40. Eligibility for owner-occupied classification. To be eligible for a property classification pursuant to § 10-13-39, the owner of each owner-occupied dwelling, as defined in § 10-13-39, shall submit a certificate to the county director of equalization stating such person is the owner and occupant of the dwelling as of the assessment date pursuant to § 10-6-2 and that the dwelling is the owner's principal place of residence as defined in § 12-1-4. If the owner occupies two or more dwellings during an assessment year, the owner shall provide the location of any other dwellings that the owner occupies when submitting the certificate. The director of equalization may request additional documentation from the owner when making the determination of eligibility. If any person submits information to the director of equalization contesting the eligibility of a dwelling to be classified as an owner-occupied single-family dwelling, the director of equalization shall review the classification and make a determination of eligibility. The owner shall state on the certificate the portion of the dwelling so occupied by the owner if it is less than fifty percent of the dwelling or if the dwelling is a duplex, triplex, or fourplex. The owner-occupant shall submit the certificate by March fifteenth. The owner of each manufactured or mobile home as defined in § 32-3-1, shall submit a certificate to the county director of equalization stating such person is the owner and occupant of the dwelling as of the assessment date. The owner-occupant of each manufactured or mobile home shall submit the certificate during the time of registration pursuant to §§ 10-9-3 to 10-9-4, inclusive. If the owner-occupant of a manufactured or mobile home fails to submit the certificate by the date or time frame required pursuant to §§ 10-9-3 to 10-9-4, inclusive, it does not affect the eligibility of the property to be classified as an owner-occupied dwelling. The owner-occupant shall sign the certificate under penalty of perjury. If the director of equalization classifies the property, mobile home, or manufactured home as owner-occupied singlefamily dwelling, it shall retain the classification until such time as the property ownership is transferred or the property has a change in use. The new owner-occupant of transferred property which is already classified as owner-occupied may meet the requirements of this section by completing and filing the certificate of value required pursuant to § 7-9-7 at the time of the transfer of the property. If the legal description of property is changed or amended and the owner continues to reside in the dwelling that is

classified as a owner-occupied single-family dwelling, the owner shall retain the owner-occupied single-family dwelling classification. The Department of Revenue shall prescribe the form of the certificate and the certificate of value required pursuant to § 7-9-7. Appeals regarding the owner-occupied classification shall be made directly to the county board of equalization pursuant to § 10-11-23.

12-1-4. Criteria for determining voting residence. For the purposes of this title, the term, residence, means the place in which a person has fixed his or her habitation and to which the person, whenever absent, intends to return.

A person who has left home and gone into another state or territory or county of this state for a temporary purpose only has not changed his or her residence.

A person is considered to have gained a residence in any county or municipality of this state in which the person actually lives, if the person has no present intention of leaving.

If a person moves to another state, or to any of the other territories, with the intention of making it his or her permanent home, the person thereby loses residence in this state.

10-13-40.3. Penalty for fraudulent receipt of owner-occupied single-family dwelling classification. Any person who receives an owner-occupied single-family dwelling classification by misrepresenting the facts as to the person's ownership or occupancy of the dwelling shall be assessed a penalty equal to ten dollars per thousand dollars of valuation on the subject dwelling, which assessment shall become a perpetual lien on the property pursuant to § 10-21-33. The person shall be barred from receiving the owner-occupied single-family dwelling classification for any property in the state for the following three years.

PURCHASE AGREEMENT

THIS PURCHASE AGREEMENT ("Agreement"), dated as of _______, 2017, (the "date pf Agreement"), is made by and between the CITY OF DEADWOOD, hereinafter ("CITY"), and Conrad Enterprises, Inc. of 52 Lincoln Ave., Deadwood, South Dakota 57732 ("BUYER").

In consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, and other valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, CITY and BUYER agree as follows:

- 1) <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this Agreement is to specify the terms and conditions under which CITY agrees to sell and BUYER agrees to buy the property.
- 2) Real Property to be Purchased. CITY agrees to sell to BUYER certain real property situated in Lawrence County, South Dakota, with the following legal description:

Lot 107B of Block 71 of Original Town of Deadwood, Lawrence County, South Dakota. Document # 2017-494

(hereinafter referred to as "The Property")

- 3) Purchase Price and Terms. The Purchase Price for the Property conveyed herein shall be Three Hundred Eighty and 00/100's Dollars (\$380.00). The Purchase Price shall be paid in full at Closing.
- 4) <u>Condition of Property</u>. BUYER acknowledges and agrees that it is purchasing the Property in an "as is, where is" condition and CITY has not made and does not make any representation or warranty of any nature as to the condition of the Property. BUYER has had the right to inspect the Property and CITY shall have no liability or obligation of any nature arising out of the condition of the Property after Closing.
- 5) <u>Title to Property and Deed.</u>
 - a. <u>Conveyance of Title</u>. CITY will deliver to Buyer a Quitclaim Deed to the Real Property conveying title.

6) Possession and Closing.

- a. <u>Closing</u>. Subject to the express contingencies set forth herein and to any conditions precedent set forth herein, the closing of the transaction (the "Closing") shall take place on or about the 1st day of November, 2017.
- b. <u>Possession</u>. BUYER shall be entitled to possession of the Property on the date of Closing.

- 7) <u>Title Insurance</u>. CITY warrants that it holds marketable title to the real property described in Section 3. Both CITY and BUYER have mutually agreed not to procure a title insurance policy for the Property. Both parties understand the risk associated with Closing without obtaining a title insurance policy and have made an independent and informed decision not to obtain a title insurance policy.
- 8) Representations of CITY. Seller represents and warrants as follows:
 - a. At the Closing, CITY will do, make, execute, and deliver to BUYER all such additional and further acts, deeds, instruments, and documents as may be reasonably required to carry out the terms and conditions hereof.
- 9) Indemnification by BUYER. Buyer shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless CITY, and its officers, directors, managers, members, employees, agents, representatives, heirs, or assigns from and against any and all claims, causes of action, suits, judgments, taxes, losses, damages, deficiencies, obligations, costs, and expenses including, without limitation, interest, penalties, and fees and costs of investigation and defense, including reasonable fees and expenses of attorneys, as an element of damage, and other experts (collectively, "Losses") arising out of BUYER'S use of the Property or otherwise in respect of the transaction set forth in this Agreement which shall accrue as a result of any action taken by BUYER following Closing.
- 10) Taxes. BUYER will be responsible for all real property taxes following closing.
- 11) Closing and Other Transaction Costs.

CITY will pay:

- a) One-half of closing costs;
- b) All transfer fees and taxes; and,
- c) CITY'S Attorney fees.

BUYER will pay:

- a) One-half the cost of insurance:
- b) All closing costs and transfer fees or taxes;
- c) The cost of recording the deeds for transferring title to the Real Property; and,
- d) BUYER'S Attorney fees
- 12) <u>Time</u>. Time is of the essence for purpose of performance under this Agreement.
- 13) <u>Severability</u>. The parties agree that if any provisions of this Agreement are held invalid such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or application of the other provisions of this Agreement which can be given without the invalid provision, and to this end, the provisions of this Agreement are declared to be severable.
- 14) <u>Effect of Agreement</u>. This Agreement shall be binding in all respects upon and shall inure to the benefit of CITY and BUYER and their respective successors and assigns.

- 15) <u>Integration</u>. The parties agree that this writing constitutes the entire agreement between them with respect to the Property and that there are no other oral or collateral agreements or understandings of any kind or character, except for the representations and warranties contained in the Agreement that concern the Property and survive for the period stated therein.
- 16) <u>Default</u>. In the event of a default herein by either party, both parties shall have all of the rights and remedies available to them under the laws of the State of South Dakota.
- 17) Entire Agreement. This Agreement and the exhibits attached hereto contain the entire agreement between the parties. No modification or amendment of this Agreement will be of any force of effect unless made in writing and executed by CITY and BUYER.
- 18) Governing Law and Venue. The parties agree that any action to enforce any rights or obligations under this Agreement shall be brought in the South Dakota Circuit Court, Lawrence County, state of South Dakota. The parties further agree that this contact and all other agreements entered in to fulfill the terms of this contract, shall be governed by and controlled by South Dakota law.
- 19) <u>Binding on Successors and Assigns</u>. This Agreement and the terms and provisions hereof will inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns whenever the context so requires or admits.
- 20) Attorney's Fees. Subject to the other provisions of this Agreement, should either party hereto institute any action or proceeding in court to enforce any provision hereof or for damages by reason of any alleged breach of any provision of this Agreement or for any other judicial remedy, the prevailing party will be entitled to receive from the losing party all reasonable attorney's fees and all court costs in connection with such proceeding.
- 21) <u>Section Headings</u>. The section headings contained in this Agreement are for convenience only and will in no way enlarge or limit the scope or meaning of the various and several sections thereof.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1266

TO AMEND CHAPTER 15.01.040 INTERNATIONAL BUILDING CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DEADWOOD, TO AMEND CHAPTER 15.01.040 AS FOLLOWS:

15.01.040 Board of appeals and examiners.

- A. Appointment. In order to hear and decide appeals of orders, decisions, or determinations made by the building official relative to the application and interpretation on the inclusive Building Code of the city of Deadwood, to review all prospective changes to the respective codes and to submit recommendations to the responsible official and the city commission, to review requests for house moves, demolitions, repairs and maintenance, and to examine applicants for licensing and to investigate matters brought before the board, there shall be and is hereby created a board of appeals and examiners, which shall not include any individual employed by the city of Deadwood. Members shall be appointed by the mayor with consent of the city commission and shall hold office for three-year terms. The board shall adopt rules of procedure for conducting its business and shall render all decisions in writing to the appellant with a duplicate copy to the building official.
- B. Limitation of Authority. An application for appeal shall be based on a claim that the true intent of the Building Code of the city of Deadwood, of the rules legally adopted thereunder, have been incorrectly interpreted, the provisions of the code do not fully apply for an equally good, or better form of construction, repair, et cetera is proposed. The board shall have no authority relative to the administrative provisions of the code nor shall the board be empowered to waive requirements of the code.
- C. Any decision by the board of appeals may be appealed directly to the Deadwood City Commission. The Deadwood City Commission shall have no authority relative to the administrative provisions of the code, nor shall the commission be empowered to waive requirements of the code. Any application for appeal to the Deadwood City Commission shall be based on a claim that the true intent of the Building Code of the city of Deadwood, of the rules legally adopted thereunder, have been incorrectly interpreted, the provisions of the code do not fully apply for an equally good, or better form of construction, repair, et cetera is proposed. Following the decision by Deadwood City Commission, an applicant who desires to appeal a decision of the Deadwood City Commission shall file an appeal with the circuit court of Lawrence County within thirty (30) days after the determination of the issue by the Deadwood City Commission in the matter provided by law.
- D. Prosecution of Violation. If the notice of violation is not complied with promptly, the building official is authorized to request the legal counsel of the jurisdiction to deem the violation as a strict liability offense and institute the appropriate proceeding at law or in equity to restrain, correct, or abate such violation, or to require the removal or termination of the unlawful occupancy of the building or structure in violation of the

provisions of the Building Code of the city of Deadwood or of the order or direction made pursuant thereto.

E. Liability. The building official, members of the board of appeals, or employees charged with the enforcement of this code, while acting for the city of Deadwood in good faith and without malice in the discharge of the duties required by the Building Code of the city of Deadwood, or other pertinent law or ordinance, shall not thereby be rendered liable personally and is hereby relieved from personal liability for any damage accruing to persons or property as a result of any act or by reason of an act or omission in the discharge of official duties. Any suit instituted against an office or employee because of the act performed by that officer or employee in the lawful discharge of duties and under the provisions of the Building Code of the city of Deadwood shall be afforded all the protection provided by the city's insurance pool and any immunities and defenses provided by the other applicable state and federal law. The building official or any subordinate shall not be liable for cost in any action, suit, or proceeding that is instituted in pursuance of the provisions of this code.

The Building Code of the city of Deadwood shall not be construed to relieve from or lessen the responsibility of any person owning, operating, or controlling any building or structure for any damages to persons or property caused by defects, nor shall the code enforcement agency or the city be held as assuming any such liability by reason of inspection authorized by this code or any permits or certifications issued under this code.

Vacation Rentals -- City Municipal Code and State Requirements

The City of Deadwood Planning and Zoning Department has been working toward solving an ongoing issue of vacation rentals in Deadwood. Currently vacation rentals in residentially zoned districts are not allowed in the city limits and are in violation of the City of Deadwood Municipal Code and in violation of State Law.

City staff has notified property owners who are in violation of the municipal code. The majority of these owners have made contact with our office and are now in compliance. However, there are still about a third of them who have not contacted Planning and Zoning and are still operating illegally. Staff will be meeting with the Chief of Police to review the 17.53.060 Violation Penalty which states "Citations will be issued to any person who violates this title or any amendment hereto. The violator, upon being found guilty, shall be punished as for a misdemeanor, and any court having jurisdiction of misdemeanor cases shall be jurisdiction to try violators and upon finding them guilty, may penalize them with a fine not exceeding two hundred dollars (\$200.00) or by imprisonment no exceeding thirty days or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each day that any violation of this title is in effect shall constitute a separate offense."

Property owners who are currently renting their property at legal locations that are zoned commercial and are licensed with the State are collecting all related taxes. These owners are operating under the City of Deadwoods commercial water rate and their trash collection is through the private sector not the City of Deadwood residential service.

The majority of these vacation rentals have been using hosting websites such as Airbnb to advertise their property. Regardless of how the rental is being advertised every rental MUST have a sales tax license and MUST be a licensed lodging establishment with the South Dakota Department of Health. An agreement between the South Dakota Department of Revenue and Airbnb was signed on July 24, 2017 stating Airbnb would begin collecting taxes for rentals in South Dakota beginning September 1, 2017. Other hosting websites are being approached regarding the same type of agreement. Airbnb is now collecting State Sales Tax, Municipal Sales Tax, Municipal Gross Receipts Tax and Tourism Tax throughout the state.
