# Hospital SWIMMING POOL CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT effective the 18th day of September, 2017, by and between the Lead-Deadwood Regional Hospital, hereinafter referred to as **HOSPITAL** and the City of Deadwood, hereinafter referred to as **CITY**.

WHEREAS the HOSPITAL and the CITY are desirous of entering into an agreement where the HOSPITAL shall contract for use of the swimming pool facility owned by the CITY, now therefore, it is mutually understood by and between parties hereto as follows:

- 1. Rent. In consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) per person in the water, per visit to the pool, the CITY agrees to rent to the HOSPITAL for its use as provided herein.
- 2. <u>Term.</u> Availability for therapy activities commencing on November 1, 2017, and ending on October 31, 2018.
- 3. <u>Termination</u>. Such term may be terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice with or without cause.
- 4. <u>Payment</u>. **HOSPITAL** agrees to pay said sum upon arrival and before entering the pool.
- 5. <u>Amendment</u>. No amendments to this agreement are valid unless in writing and signed by both parties.
- 6. Condition of Pool. CITY agrees to maintain the pool in a safe and usable condition. It is agreed between the parties that in the event the pool should become unsafe, inaccessible, unusable, or inoperable, through no fault of CITY, CITY will not be in breach. This agreement is divisible, and consideration will be pro-rated in the event the pool should become unusable for any reason. Area to be used at any given time shall be at the discretion of CITY staff, depending on the needs of the pool facility, to include size of area, location of area and exclusivity of use of area.
- 7. <u>Indemnity</u>. **HOSPITAL** agrees to indemnify and hold **CITY** harmless from any and all liabilities, claims, demands, actions or causes of action in any way arising of **HOSPITAL'S** use of the pool and its accompanying facilities.
- 8. <u>Insurance</u>. **HOSPITAL** agrees to list **CITY** as an additional insured party with **HOSPITAL'S** insurance carrier. **HOSPITAL** also agrees to provide **CITY** with a certificate of said insurance showing **CITY** as additional insured. This certificate shall be provided to **CITY** before **HOSPITAL'S** use shall commence.

- 9. <u>Supervision</u>. **HOSPITAL** releases **CITY** from any supervisory obligation and agrees to be completely responsible for the safety and health of all persons using the pool facilities under this agreement during the term set forth above. **HOSPITAL** agrees to be fully responsible for all damages, destruction or any other loss resulting to **CITY** as a result of the use of the pool facilities by **HOSPITAL**.
- 10. <u>Additional Compensation</u>. **HOSPITAL** agrees to compensate **CITY** at a rate of Twenty-five and No/100ths Dollars (\$25.00) per staff hour for any additional services requested in writing by **HOSPITAL** in connection with the use of the pool facilities.
- 11. <u>Assignment</u>. The terms, conditions, and covenants contained in this agreement and any amendments hereto shall bind and inure to the benefit of **CITY** and **HOSPITAL** and their respective successors, heirs, legal representatives and assigns. No assignment of this agreement is valid unless in writing and signed by both parties.
- 12. <u>Choice of Law</u>. This agreement shall be governed by and construed under the laws of the State of South Dakota.
- 13. <u>Severability</u>. In the event that any provisions of this agreement shall be held invalid or unenforceable, no other provisions of this lease shall be affected by such holding, and all of the remaining previsions of this lease shall continue in full force and effect pursuant to the terms herein.
- 14. Entire Agreement. This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties hereto and pertaining to this matter and may not be modified or changed except by an express written agreement signed by both parties.

### **ORDINANCE NUMBER 1264**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DEADWOOD, THAT CHAPTER 5.48, VEHICLE FOR HIRE SHALL BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

### 5.48.085 Available License.

If a license should become available after revocation following hearing by City Commission, or expiration, the City Commission shall initiate sealed bid process upon notice from interested party. The sealed bid process shall conform to provisions of SDCL 5-18A.

### 5.48.130 Suspension-Revocation of License.

The city commission of the city of Deadwood may revoke any license issued under the provisions of this chapter upon proof that the licensee has violated provisions hereof, or upon-proof that such licensee is unfit to perform the service authorized by such license. Whenever information of an ordinance violation comes to said city commission which is believed by said commission to justify revocation of such license, notice shall be mailed to such licensee at the address set out in the application made by such licensee for license hereunder stating the intention of such city to revoke said license, and informing said licensee that it may have a public hearing before said city commission upon such question if it makes demand for such hearing within ten (10) days after the date of certified mailing of such notice; provided however, that if said city commission deems that the public interests require it, the right of any licensee hereunder may be suspended without previous notice, such suspension to remain in effect until hearing, or waiver of hearing by failure to ask for same, upon the question of revocation of such license. Each licensee has the duty under this chapter to keep the city of Deadwood informed as to the current address for purposes of notification herein and it shall not be a defense hereunder that the city had an incorrect address.

Any license issued under this chapter may be revoked, for cause, by the Commission, after notice to the holder of the license and an opportunity for hearing before the Commission. The Chief of Police shall have the authority to suspend any license issued under this chapter for good cause pending a hearing before the Commission. The power to suspend the license shall be exercised only if it shall appear to the Chief of Police that there is probably cause to believe that the holder of the license has failed to meet all requirements set forth in this chapter or by violating any conditions required of a license holder under this chapter. The holder of any license suspended by the Chief of Police shall have a right to a hearing before the Chief of Police within 72 hours of a written request therefor. As used herein the term Chief of Police shall include the Chief of Police and any subordinate officer temporarily acting as the office in charge of the Police Department.

Please see attached letters and supporting Attachments. Bob Morcom and I just met on this and it's much clearer to me now. Most of the request is based on the change in the approved OH rate between the time the Work Order was written and what was actually billed out. This is no longer a question of whether or not the Scope of Work changed or was exceeded.

Item #1 – Bob is showing what the new Not To Exceed amount would be due to the OH rate change.

Item #2 — Bob is adding in hours that were erroneously billed to the City of Deadwood — at the new OH rate. Note that even with these hours added back in, TSP is not exceeding the hours originally estimated in the Work Order. Original Estimate was 320 hours; actual final is 315 hours.

Item #3 – There was a mis-understanding while preparing the CE/CA Work Order regarding the role of the Landscape Architect, Designworks. Ultimately it appears Designworks should have been a sub-consultant to TSP on the CE/CA Work Order. We discussed the services they provided, which were shop drawing reviews, and initial and final inspection of the work. Bob is going to contact Designworks to obtain records that substantiate their role with regards to the \$1000, but my initial take is that it truly is Contract Administration work. Can we add this to the CE/CA Work Order retro-actively?

What Bob is requesting appears reasonable to me. Please advise if this is acceptable from Audit's standpoint.

Following our meeting on May 10th with Don Wrede and Ron Green, we went back and reviewed the overall DOT scope of the original contract, determined what time originally charged to the City of Deadwood was within the DOT scope, and determined what had changed from our original contract and should be acceptable for payment. Please note that we have removed any time that should not have been charged to the work order and was attributed to our responsibility to resolve. From that review there are three Items that we would like you to again consider for additional fees:

- Revision to our contract NTE based on some of our SDDOT negotiated hourly labor rates changing including individuals that worked on or were added to the project, and a revision of our allowable overhead rate that changed between the time the work order for this project was initiated and the time that we actually started work on the project. (See attachment A.)
- 2. Request for services that were billed to the City of Deadwood, but should have been billed to the DOT and fall into services that were within the scope of the original DOT contract.
- 3. Reimbursement for Designworks landscaped architect's fee that was not paid for by the City of Deadwood or SDDOT, but in our original agreement with Deadwood to be used for CA. TSP has paid Designworks for their services.

Please note, the total hours used in this request is less than the hours estimated in our original contract.

Following is a summary of the cost implications of Items 1-3 on the limit to our Not to exceed contract:

The original work order R-03-14 for this project, dated December 30, 2014, was 1. under our Agreement Number 410553. Because of the Contractor's schedule, we did not begin work on this project until after a revision of our allowable overhead rate was issued by the SDDOT Internal Service Program - Audits office. This revision of our allowable overhead rates was dated February 25, 2015 and a copy of the letter is attached. This revision increased our allowable overhead rate from the 130.98% used in the original project work order to 171.35%. This overhead rate was applied to our very first billing invoice through the end of our work on the project.

- a. Our **original** estimated costs and hours with the 130.98% overhead rate are summarized as follows (See total breakdown Attachment A and B):
