



8:00 am to 2:00 am

The growing season has begun. As per the City of Deadwood Ordinance: 8.20.020—Duty of owner, occupant, or person in charge. It is the duty of the owner, occupant, or person in charge of any lot in the city to keep such lot free from weeds as defined herein or to cut such weeds at such times as may be necessary to prevent their growth. Weeds and grass left uncut cause an unsightly appearance, create a fire hazard, and offer an environment conducive to rodents and small animals.
