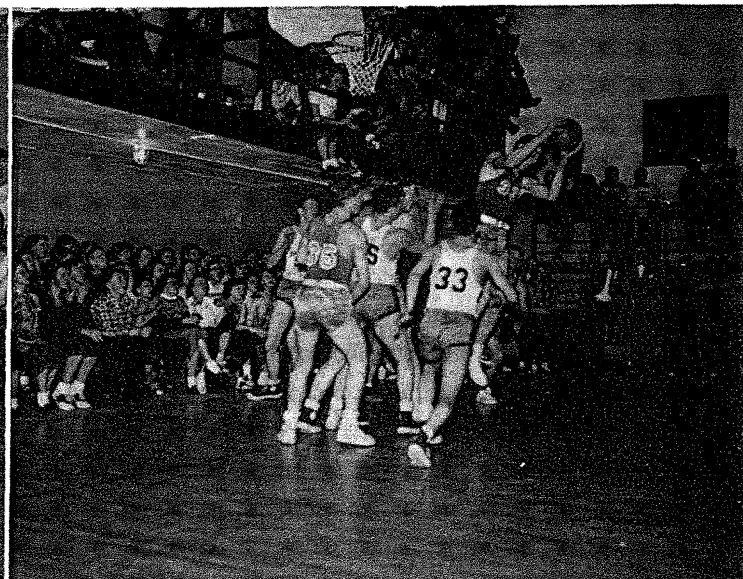
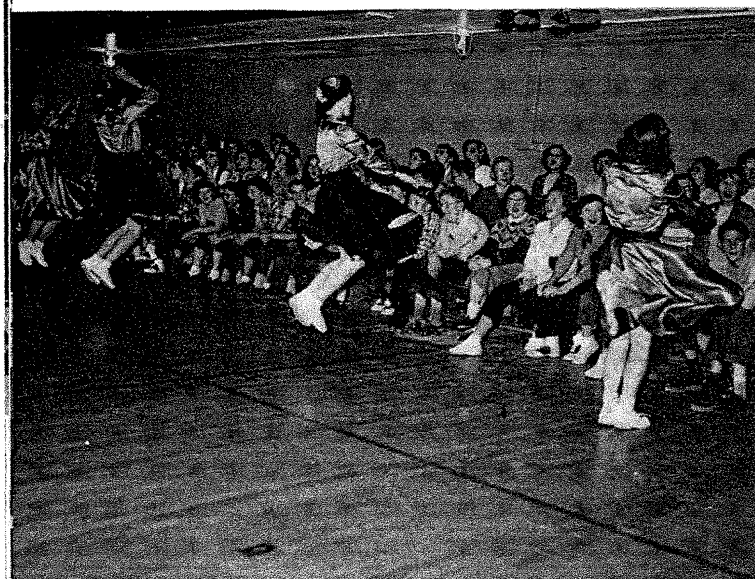
# Sports

Say, we really did have a couple of good teams this year. Our football team won 85.6% of their games and the basketball team shone through with a 66.7 percentage.

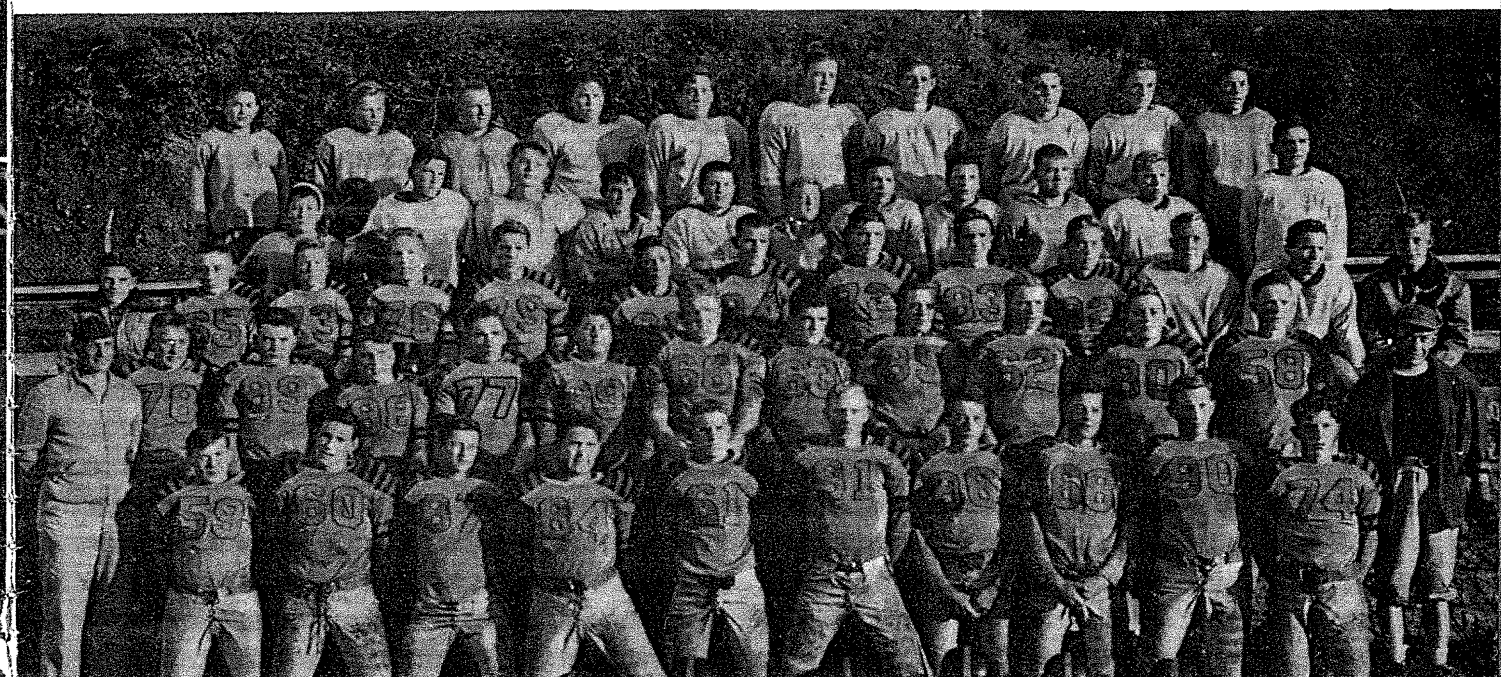


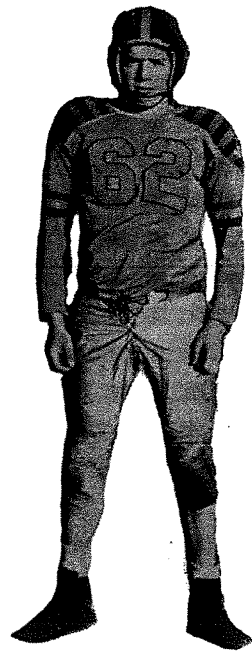
