I HEREBY CERTIFY THAT I HAVE READ AND EXAMINED THIS APPLICATION AND KNOW THE SAME TO BE TRUE AND CORRECT. Conditions Of Issuance

1. A surety bond in the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) or project cost, whichever is greater, for faithful performance of all duties required by the city and for repayment to the city for all damages growing out of the carelessness or negligence of such permittee; and
2. A certificate of insurance showing that the applicant has in effect a statutory Workers' Compensation insurance policy, including employer's liability coverage in the amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00), and a liability policy covering business operations, including coverage for explosion, collapse, and underground hazards, commonly referred to as XCU coverage, and including coverage for owned and non-owned vehicles with limits of not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for each occurrence, and five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) for injury to or destruction of the property of others. Such certificate shall contain a statement to the effect that the policy cannot be canceled or substantially altered without ten (10) days' prior written notice to the city.
